ave you ever wondered what it's like to experience the thrills and beauty of one of our three-day/four-night heli hiking or heli mountaineering adventures? One of our guests (thank you!) suggested that we share a typical itinerary, which we thought was a great idea. So . . . here goes!

Arrival Day

Most of our guests arrive at an airport such as Vancouver or Kelowna in British Columbia or Calgary, Alberta — that's where they pick up a prebooked rental car and head to the historic town of Revelstoke, British Columbia. Armed with the rental car, they can then enjoy the freedom to explore the Revelstoke area when they're not hiking or mountaineering. (Of course, we can also arrange pick-up at the airports by either land or air, if you'd prefer not to drive yourself.)

Once you reach Revelstoke, you'll check in at your accommodation, and join us for heli safety briefings (everything you ever wanted to know about heli-

copters — just ask!), waiver signings and gear checks (that's when we make sure that you have everything you need to enjoy the alpine back-country). Then it's off to a fun meet-and-greet to get to know your fellow travelers (if you don't know them already, of course!) before dinner.

Adventure Days!

Here's where the fun really starts!! You can start the day with a stretching class, a gentle way to get all of your muscles warmed up and ready for the day's activities. Then it's off to a hearty breakfast, complete with everything you could ask for, from fruit and yoghurt to eggs and bacon. You'll be able to build your lunch, too, with plenty of healthy options for sandwiches, fruit and veggies, and easily transportable desserts (can you say "cookies"?).

disturb them as little as possible — and we never "follow" wildlife using the helicopter. Whether it's deer or smaller critters, we feel very deeply that this is their home, and we're just visiting.

But oh, what a visit! The helicopter will take us to the day's heli hiking or heli mountaineering start point, where we'll step into backcountry so pristine that it rarely sees human footprints. Your guide selects these routes based on how far and fast you'd like to go — and all speeds are welcomed, from strolling to striding.

Along the way, you'll be amazed at how much these knowledgeable folks can share about the landscape. From the alpine flowers at your feet to the glaciers gleaming above you, they know the land intimately. They also know the wildlife, and can show you signs that indicate where a deer and her fawn slept the night before, or where an eagle has its young concealed (hint: look waaaay up!).

So what are you doing while all of this learning is happening? Hikers will be walking through terrain as varied as forest, meadows, lakeshores, talus (boulder) fields and even glaciers. Mountaineers will be heading up, but there's little technical expertise needed — this is just about stepping up and up... it's more strenuous than hiking and more focused on getting to the peaks, but it's still tailored to your comfort level and ability.

Whew! What a view, what a day, what an adventure. You'll board the helicopter for the trip back to the hotel by 4:30 p.m., being whisked off to appetizers, drinks and stories of the day's adventures. If you need to work out a few of the day's muscle kinks, massage is available, then it's dinner at 7 p.m. and off to bed — our guests tell us that they always sleep well!

The next morning — you get to explore the back-country all over again!

The GST Dance

The Canadian Goods & Services Tax is our federal tax on — you guessed it — most goods and services across the country. We're no exception, so we've taken the guesswork out of the equation, and calculated it into our pricing. You'll notice that trip costs look slightly different for international (including US) and Canadian guests: International guest prices include the federal government's visitor GST rebate of 3% (meaning that international guests only pay 2%); Canadian prices include the full 5% GST.
